Limit of 10 dogs per envelope. No hand deliveries can be accepted in the first 24 hours.

NOTE: A new version of the AKC Agility Entry Form is effective January 1, 2010. You must check the height card status for your dog and sign the "back" side of the entry form.

If you would like confirmation that your entry was received before the trial has closed, please include your email address or enclose a self-addressed stamped postcard. Entries cannot be changed once the trial has closed. **Please check your entries!**

Dogs Eligible to Enter

This trial is open to all dogs over the age of 15 months that are registered with the American Kennel Club or are registerable breeds that have obtained an AKC or ILP/PAL number, except bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect a dog's physical or mental performance. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Rules Applying to Registration and Discipline for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate.

Running Order

Two rings will be used, alternating between Ring 1 Standard and Ring 2 JWW.

Class Order - Regular and Preferred will be run together at each height.

Move-ups

For the Friday, March 12, trial (or the first trial day entered): MOVE-UPS close at 6:00 pm CST, Monday, March 8. For the Saturday, March 13, and Sunday, March 14, trials: MOVE-UPS close 30 minutes after the end of the trial on Friday, March 12 and Saturday, March 13 respectively. Move-ups may be sent by regular mail or email to the Trial Secretary. If an email address is provided with your entry, an email confirmation of the move-up will be sent.

Trial Information

The building is available for **set up Friday, February 12 at 10:00 am.**

Trial hours are 12:00 pm to 7:00 pm on Friday and 7:00 am to 7:00 pm on Saturday and Sunday.

Walkthrough and judge's briefing for the first class on Friday will be at 12:30 pm; judging will start at 1:00 pm. Walkthrough and judge's briefing for the first class on Saturday and Sunday will be 7:30 am; judging will start at 8:00 am.

Ring size: 90' x 98' each (2 rings). The arena is climate-controlled with indoor restrooms and bleacher seating. Please bring crates and water for your dogs and clean up supplies.

AKC Jump Height Cards - NOTE NEW RULES EFFECTIVE 1/1/10

All dogs competing in agility must **possess** an official AKC Jump Height Card. An official AKC Jump Height Card is defined as either a permanent jump height card, a valid temporary jump height form, copies of two different measuring forms (placing the dog in the same height class) dated on or after the dog's second birthday, or copies of three different measuring forms (two of which place the dog in the same height class) on or after the dog's second birthday. All dogs **except those jumping 24" or 26" (unless a VMO or AKC Representative is present)** without permanent or temporary height cards must be measured.

You are not required to show your height card or send a copy with your entry. You are required to mark on your entry form your dog's height card status. It is the exhibitor's responsibility to request measurement. If your dog does not have a valid height card for a trial and is not measured by a VMO, if present, any qualifying runs earned will be disallowed. There will be VMOs at this trial.

Show Regulations

Declination of entries: The Tri-State Kennel Club, Inc. may decline entries for cause and may refuse to receive or may remove any dog on account of aggression, disease, deformity, injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No one shall have any claim or recourse against the Tri-State Kennel Club, Inc. or any official thereof.

Bitches in season are not permitted in the Trial. The club will refund all of the entry fees less \$5.00 per day for bitches unable to compete for that reason. The Trial Secretary must receive notification of such a claim for refund by letter hand-delivered, emailed, or post-marked on or before March 12, 2010.

Entry fees will not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Trial Committee.

If, because of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of god, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee or other acts beyond the control of the Trial Committee, it is impossible to open or to complete this trial, no refund of entry fees will be made.

Exhibitors must be governed by any rules or regulations of civil authorities, and building and parking restrictions. Vehicles parked contrary to regulations will be subject to towing at owner's expense.

Notice to Exhibitors

The safety of the dogs is our primary concern. By entering these trials, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Trial Committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made.

All dogs must be on leash or crated at all times except when in the ring or when in the designated agility warm-up area.

Exhibitors are responsible for being at the ring gate when it is their turn to run. The judge need not wait for any dog holding up a class. Tri-State Kennel Club, Inc. has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or steward for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought to the ring when required.

Entries must be made on Official AKC entry forms or copies and must include the signed Agreement and Rules. Junior Handlers must include their Junior Handler number.

Include only AKC titles on entries.

Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may have made such errors. No entry will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Errors in entries made by the exhibitor cannot be corrected after the closing date. No refunds for duplicate entries.

Dogs under 6 months of age are not permitted on the show grounds of AKC Agility Trials.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites and any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. There is a \$25 returned check fee. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitor may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

No flash photography permitted while a dog is running on the course.

Prizes and Awards

Ribbons will be awarded to First Place through Fourth Place in each jump height in each class. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving a qualifying score. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons.

1st place	Blue
2nd place	Red
3rd place	Yellow
4th place	White
Qualifying	Green

A MACH ribbon and bar will be awarded to any dog finishing a MACH title at these trials. A PAX ribbon and bar will be awarded to any dog finishing a PAX title at these trials. A new title ribbon will be awarded to any dog finishing a title at these trials. Dogs qualifying in both Excellent B Standard and Excellent B JWW at the same trial will receive a "Double-Q" ribbon.

Handlers may opt to enter in a higher height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Mixed breed classes may only be offered at standalone all-breed AKC agility trials. A standalone agility event is defined as an agility trial that is not held on the same date and show site as an AKC All-Breed Dog Show or independent Specialty for conformation. Dogs entered in the mixed breed classes must list the breed name as "mixed breed" and not as a breed hybrid.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.

Mixed breed classes may only be offered at standalone all-breed AKC agility trials. A standalone agility event is defined as an agility trial that is not held on the same date and show site as an AKC All-Breed Dog Show or independent Specialty for conformation. Dogs entered in the mixed breed classes must list the breed name as "mixed breed" and not as a breed hybrid.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 816-3776. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
